Important Notes:

- This test is meant to serve as an indicator, not a conclusive result. The results should be considered in light of personal revelation from God, Godly counsel from mature and trusted believers, and personal experience and observations.
- This test does not include tongues and interpretation of tongues because these gifts are easy to recognize independently of a test.
- This test lists only the gifts specifically named in the Bible. While we are open to the idea that there may be more gifts, we decided to limit our testing to those with concrete backing in scripture for training purposes.
- This specific test is not meant to address the *offices* of the five-fold ministry: Apostles, Prophets, Pastors, Teachers, and Evangelists.

Definitions and Scripture References:

Administration

1 Corinthians 12:28

Those operating in this gift have a divinely given ability to organize, coordinate, and integrate people, projects, information, and resources toward defined goals. They find joy in helping things run smoothly toward those ends. They see enhancing efficiency as a type of ministry.

Discernment

1 Corinthians 12:10

Those operating in this gift have a divinely given ability to recognize spiritual influences good or bad, and fleshly motivations that are at work in people and situations. They are quick to see red flags that would ordinarily be missed, and conversely, they also see the true and honorable motivations in people that others may have missed or misinterpreted.

Exhortation

Romans 12:6

(Also known as the gift of encouragement). Those operating in this gift have a divinely given ability to encourage and strengthen others through the Word of God and Godly counsel. They are often sought out by people who are frightened, hurt, angry, confused, or in despair. They are able to release God's power through words in such a way as to instill love, joy, peace, comfort, hope, and faith.

Faith

1 Corinthians 12:9, and 13:2

Those operating in this gift have a divinely given ability to believe with absolute certainty that God's promises and words will come to pass and to take action accordingly. They understand what God wants to accomplish and agree with those plans. Through their faith, they keep themselves and others on track towards God's goals. They are often used by God to influence those around them to greater levels of faith.

Giving

Romans 12:6, 1 Corinthians 13:3

Those operating in this gift have a divinely given ability to share their wealth and resources generously and joyfully. They eagerly look for opportunities to give. They see standard tithing as simply a starting point and look to fully increase their giving to the Lord's work possible. They see an increase in their own finances as an opportunity to help others. They see giving as planting seeds in God's kingdom and as a type of ministry.

Healing

1 Corinthians 12:9

Those operating in this gift have a divinely given ability to administer supernatural healing to the sick or injured. They operate under the assumption that God wants to heal his people and see praying for the infirm as an opportunity to free people from pain and disease.

Helps

1 Corinthians 12:28

Those operating in this gift have a divinely given ability to use their own talents, abilities, and resources to help others. They are people-oriented and see giving assistance as a way to show God's love to others. They are often committed to helping a specific individual or ministry.

Hospitality

1 Peter 4:9

Those operating in this gift have a divinely given ability to welcome into their homes those who are in need of food or shelter. They are happier having guests in their homes than not and see opening their homes to others as a type of ministry.

Knowledge

1 Corinthians 12:8, and 13:2

Those operating in this gift have a divinely given ability to obtain, discover, understand, clarify, and retain facts and information. They are able to connect pieces of information from various topics and sources to see a more complete picture. They are well-versed in many subjects and are a resource for others. They utilize their knowledge to further growth in the Body of Christ on individual and corporate levels.

Leadership

Romans 12:6

Those operating in this gift have a divinely given ability to unify others and stir them to action for God's purposes. They are able to inspire, chastise, motivate, and direct as needed. They understand God's goals and recruit people of various giftings to create a diversified core group that can get the job done. They rally others to do God's work and keep them focused on the big picture.

Mercy

Romans 12:6

Those operating in this gift have a divinely given ability to feel empathy for those in distress and to show love and kindness even to those who are undeserving. They give help and encouragement to those who are struggling. They are ready to give people a second chance or a third. They are instrumental not only in reaching out to the lost but also in restoring those believers who have fallen.

Miracles

1 Corinthians 12:10

Those operating in this gift are used by God to perform miracles, signs, and wonders. Supernatural power flows through them and helps point people towards God or towards a deeper revelation of him. They find joy in seeing God demonstrate his power.

Prophecy

Acts 19:6, Romans 12:6, 1 Corinthians 12:10, 13:2, and 14:1

Those operating in this gift have a divinely given ability to deliver messages from God. They receive information from God in many ways, including visions, dreams, pictures, or words, and relay that information to others as God directs them. They find joy in knowing that God speaks clearly to us about where we have been and where we are going, and count it a privilege to relay his words to others.

Service

Romans 12:6

Those operating in this gift have a divinely given ability to use their own talents, abilities, and resources to complete tasks that further God's purposes. They are task-oriented, and when they see projects that they are qualified to help with, they are eager to get involved. They see this as an important way to progress the kingdom of God.

Teaching

Romans 12:6

Those operating in this gift have a divinely given ability to inform and instruct others. They can take complex information and make it simple and accessible to others. They are able to engage the interest and understanding of those listening. When they learn something new that is relevant to the Body of Christ, they see relaying that information to others as a type of ministry.

Wisdom

1 Corinthians 12:8

Those operating in this gift have a divinely given ability to know how the Holy Spirit would have them best handle people and situations. They can make sense of information presented and determine the correct course of action. They can quickly get to the heart of a matter and settle it. They live by the tried-and-true principles in the Word of God and counsel others on how they can do the same.
